


## **Unified HKUST, Complementary Campuses**









## PhD Program in IPE

- Medium of Instruction: English
- Program Duration
  - 3 years (with a relevant research master's degree)
  - 4 years (without a relevant research master's degree)
- Two Supervisors
  - Prime supervisor: IPE faculty
  - Co-supervisor: From a different field (e.g., PPOL)




## PhD Program in IPE

- Minimum Credit Requirement
  - 21 credits
- PhD Qualifying Examination in the Second Year
  - Written exam + Dissertation proposal and defense
  - Maximum of two attempts
- Doctoral Thesis
  - 3 chapters



## PhD Program in IPE





#### Postgraduate Studentship

- Fully funded by their supervisors
  - 3 years guaranteed with a relevant MPhil degree prior to entering the PhD program;
  - 4 years guaranteed without a relevant MPhil degree prior to entering the PhD program.
- The monthly amount for a PGS is RMB¥15,000, or RMB¥180,000 each year (12-month basis).



## **Student Body**

- 3 cohorts since 2019 (HKUST GZ Pilot Scheme)
- 6-10 students admitted per year
- UG/PG majors:
  - Economics/Management/Math/Finance/Accounting
  - Public Policy/Technology Leadership and Entrepreneurship
- Currently 3 International students



## **Tips for Applicants**

- Choose Your Potential Prime Supervisor
  - Mandatory in the application form
- Email Your Potential Prime Supervisor
  - Keep it simple
  - Your Background (attach CV and transcript)
  - Your Research Interest (attach proposal)



## **Tips for Applicants**

- 2-3 Recommendation Letters
- Research Experience
  - RA/Independent Study
  - Published/R&R/Submitted papers
  - Academic & Research-related awards
- Research Proposal
  - Important!
  - Relevant to innovation, policy, and entrepreneurship
  - Empirical/Theoretical



## **English Language Admission Requirements**

- English Language requirements
  - TOEFL-iBT: ≥ 80
  - or IELTS (Academic Module): Overall score  $\geq$  6.5, and all sub-score  $\geq$  5.5
- Applicants are not required to present TOEFL or IELTS score if
  - their first language is English, or
  - they obtained a bachelor's degree (or equivalent) from an institution where the medium of instruction was English.
- GRE/GMAT is not required, but good score is a plus.



#### **Interview**

- Shortlisted applicants will be interviewed
- 15-20 minutes
- Prime and co-supervisors + other IPE faculty
- Prime supervisor's opinion weights the most in the admission decisions



#### **Application Timeline and Procedures**

- 1 September 2021: Applications open
- 15 December 2021: First round applications close
- 1 March 2022: Second round applications close
- Apply EARLY!
- Mid-August 2022: Program registration
- Check the application procedures at <u>pg.ust.hk/apply</u>
- Apply online at <u>pg.ust.hk/applynow</u>
- Indicate your wish to be considered for admission under the *Pilot Scheme* by checking the relevant box in the Online Admission System
